Actions by the first Town Council

- 2/23/1931 On motion, the following resolution was adopted.
Resolved that in conformity with the provisions of the Acts of Assembly of Virginia approved May 30 1930, page 783, the Judge of the Circuit Court of Clarke County be and is hereby requested to appoint a Trial Justice for the County of Clarke Virginia, at a salary of 600 per year, and resolved further, that this Council agree to the provisions of said act of the adoption of this resolution.
- 4/16/1931 On motion, the following resolution was adopted. Whereas, we the members of the Common Council of the Town of Boyce, feel that the Count Road east o the Shenandoah River in the County of Clarke, State of Virginia, constitutes an important connecting link between State Highway Route #36 and State Highway Route #54, and likewise serves a large area of this county and people, and
Whereas, we believe that the County of Clarke should be given additional mileage of farm to market roads by the State Highway Commission under existing law; that the above said area of the County with a large number of people living therein, should be given an improved road, and that the interest of the County of Clarke would be ??? more by the allocation of this said road to the Highway System than any other road of similar mileage which could be taken over by the State Highway System at this time, therefore,
Be it resolved by the Common Council of the Town of Boyce, Virginia in regular meeting assembled this 16th day of April, 1931, that the State Highway Commission be requested to take over, as a part of the State Highway System, for construction and maintenance out of the State Highway Gap Fund the above mentioned road situation on the western side of the Blue Ridge Mountain and east of the Shenandoah River in the County of Clarke, constituting an important connecting road between State Highway Route #36 and State Highway Route #54, and
Be it further resolved that a copy of this Resolution be presented to the Chairman of the State Highway Commission, one copy then be sent to the State Highway Commission for this District and likewise a copy thereof to be spread upon the minutes of this meeting.
