BOYCE HISTORICAL TIDBIT

Actions by the first Town Council

- 2/17/2013 Approval to purchase dynamo for \$250.00
Motion to obtain \$1000 for paying demands and perfecting the installation of electric light system
- 5/5/1913 Unlawful to obstruct street, alley or public highway or ditch or water drain along same
No alcohol in or within 25 feet of Town Light House
Electric cut off if not paid within 15 days of due date
- 5/19/1913 Proposed adjustment to cutting off electric ordinance -- failed
No gambling ordinance
- 6/27/1913 BR Diffenderfer to do the work on electric lines
- 8/4/1913 Mr Pollard agreed to set up switch board for dynamo
- 8/18/1913 Tax rate .40/\$100 and .55 pole tax on all males over 21 except old soldiers

DMV STOP ORDINANCE

Approved and adopted after Public Hearing on May 3, 2022 at 7:00 pm.

“SECTION 50.08(a) The Treasurer of the Town of Boyce may enter into an agreement with the Commissioner of the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles whereby the Commissioner will refuse to issue or renew any vehicle registration of any applicant therefor who owes to the Town any vehicle license fees, delinquent tangible personal property tax, or Town parking citations. This is pursuant to § 46.2-752J of the Code of Virginia. The Treasurer may add the cost of any fee imposed by the Commissioner to the Town under the agreement to the delinquent tax bill or the amount of the parking citation.”

All current delinquent personal property bills shown in adjoining list will be immediately referred to DMV for this action.
