Trash/Recycling

There have been questions recently about recycling. We have attempted to get recycling but the cost is very high. But, there are options that can work. The best right now might be a neighborhood recycling program. Someone volunteers to take recycling to the landfill convenience center on a specific day.

We will continue to try to find options in the near future.

Please remember that our contract with D&D Trash Service has these restrictions:

- Only two (2) cans per household, with a limited weight of 75 pounds per can. (Please bag the trash so it does not build up in the bottom of the larger cans. It is not safe to require them to pick up the larger cans to dump them.)
- Please do not include hazardous materials, furniture, yard waste, appliances or construction debris in regular trash.
- Please break down all cardboard boxes.

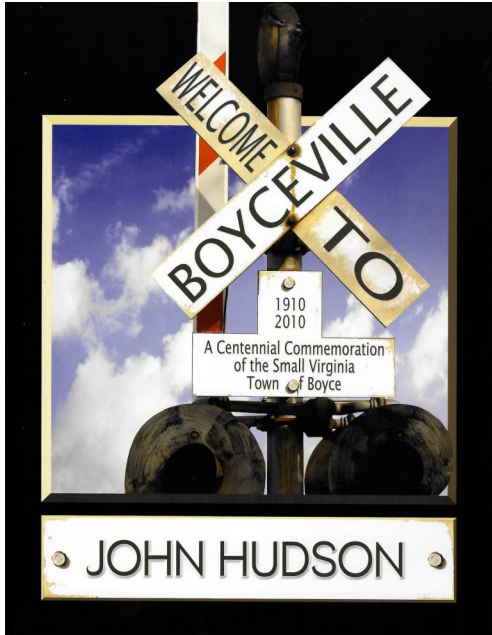
ANGEL TREE

TOWN COUNCIL ASKS FOR DETAILED REQUESTS FOR AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN FUNDS USAGE AT NOVEMBER 2, 2021 TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

These requests must fit within the following four categories and include costs incurred between March 13, 2020 through March 3, 2021.

- * Negative economic impacts by providing assistance to households.
- * Negative economic impacts by providing assistance to small businesses.
- * Negative economic impacts by providing assistance to nonprofits.
- * Investments in stormwater management within the Town limits

All detailed requested need to be turned into the office by November 24, 2021 to be considered.

2021 Real Estate Tax update

Real Estate Taxes

The only difference in Real Estate tax this year is that we will not be sending out anything to say the payment request has been sent to the mortgage company.

Each year we send a spreadsheet with the listing of all properties that each mortgage company pays. The sending of the bills to the homeowner and the mortgage company is actually redundant.
