BOYCE HISTORICAL TIDBIT
Actions by the first Town Council

6/7/1915	E S Cooper resignation
6/17/1915	C Van Deventer elected to fill vacancy of E S Cooper
7/19/1915	Petition requesting increase of Town speed limit from 8 to 12 mph.
8/30/1915	Northern Virginia Power Company accepted as franchise for electric power in Boyce
9/8/1915	Frank Tumblin Jr employed for \$25 per month as Chief of Police
11/15/1915	Burning of the cost of street lamps during one-half of the night was quite fully discussed. The Town is looking for a better rate than \$12 per light per year
1/3/1916	F Tumblin Jr was re-elected as Chief of Police for \$15 per month and 50 cents per each conviction
2/7/1916	Salary for F Tumblin Jr adjusted to \$12 per month - or \$2 for Saturday day and night or \$1 for Saturday night

TAX DISCOUNTS

1. **PERSONAL PROPERTY:** Any person who is 65 years old or older shall receive a 50% reduction in the fee charged for the issuance of any license issued for any vehicle owned or leased by that person. **(Contact office for application)**
2. **DISABLED VETERAN:** A license may be issued free of charge for any one motor vehicle owned and used personally by any veteran who holds a current state motor vehicle registration card establishing that he has received a disabled veteran's exemption from the Department of Motor Vehicles and has been issued a disabled veteran's motor vehicle license plate as prescribed in Code of Virginia § 46.2-739. **(Contact office for application)**
3. **REAL ESTATE:** Tax Relief for Elderly and Disabled applies when one of the property owners reaches age 65 in the year prior to the year for which the exemption is sought. Tax Relief for Elderly and Disabled applications must be filed with the Clarke County Commissioner of Revenue and are due April 1 of the year in which the relief is sought.
